## Frequently Asked Questions

*Groups of 3 or more buses are encouraged to split up the days they visit, in order to increase the chance of getting into the Presidential Museum. Failure to do so may result in your group having unequal times at each site; with the possibility that the entire group will have split schedules, such as some of your group going to New Salem while the others are in town. Finally, groups with 3 or more buses may not get to visit all the sites requested due to very limited time slots available.*

### Scheduling:

- \*Groups of 15 or more are required to have a schedule from the SCVB
- \*Done on a first-come, first serve-basis
- \*Processed according to season (fall/winter, spring/summer) ie: Spring of '11 requests submitted the previous year may not be processed until the Fall '10 requests are completed
- \*Allow several (approx. 10 weeks) to receive a confirmation

### Cost of Trip:

- \*Accredited schools groups: June-February, Pres. Museum is free. March-May \$4.00 per student no charge for chaperones 1:10 ratio
- \*Chaperones over the 1:10 ratio, \$12.00 per person
- \*All sites, with an exception of the Pres. Museum, are free year round when scheduled in advance through the SCVB
- \*Youth and non-accredited school groups require admission to the Presidential Museum

### Chaperones:

- \*1:10 chaperone/teacher ratio per student
- \*Keeping chaperones to the 1:10 ratio will increase chances of group entry

### Group Size:

- \*Average size is 57-60 people per bus or coach
- \*All site tours are based on a maximum number of people per tour, it is VITAL that we know ahead of time exactly how many people will be in your group
- \*If there is a change in the number of children or adults please send us a copy of the confirmation with the correct numbers, via fax (217) 544-8711 or US Mail

### When to Visit:

- \*Planning your visit November-March is best as sites are less busy and some may offer special programs.
- \*Thursdays and Fridays in October and March-May are extremely busy
- \*You may still request tours during this time; however please be aware your choice dates and sites may not be available
- \*Presidential Museum only requests are encouraged on Mondays and Tuesdays

### When requests are accepted:

- \*March-May requests will only be accepted postmarked June 1st of the previous year or after
- \*Fall requests are accepted postmarked January 1st of that year or after
- \*Access our website to download a School/Youth Group Reservation Request Form
- \*All requests received prior to the above dates will be returned

### Short Notice Request:

- \*It may not be possible to process a request with less than 30 days notice. Please keep this in mind when submitting

### Schedule Change:

- \*Done in writing on school letterhead and signed by the tour coordinator
- \*Either sent in by fax (217)544-8711 or US Mail
- \*Done in order received
- \*Multiple schedule changes may not be possible depending on the time of year

### Day of Trip:

- \*Chaperones MUST stay with their group of 10 at all times. Failure to do so may cause the group to forfeit tour
- \*Improper conduct may result in forfeiting tour
- \*Please be prompt for all tour times

### Downtown Springfield

- **Abraham Lincoln Presidential Museum** (2.5 hrs.)  
Holographic and special effects theaters, interactive displays and multi-media programs. 1861 Reproduction of the White House. Accredited school groups: June - February free, March - May \$4.00 per student. No charge for chaperones 1:10 ratio.  
Chaperones over 1:10 ratio \$12.00 per person  
Youth groups-admission.  
Self-guided tour. 9 - 5
- **Lincoln Home National Historic Site** (1 hr.)  
The only home Lincoln ever owned. Guided tour of home; includes self guided tour of Neighborhood and Visitors Center. Restrooms. 8:30 - 5
- ◆ **Old State Capitol State Historic Site** (30 min.)  
Lincoln delivered his famous "House Divided" speech here. Guided tour. 9 - 5  
Closed: Sun. & Mon., Sept. - April.
- ◆ **Lincoln-Herndon Law Office State Historic Site** (30 min.)  
Constructed in 1840, this is the only surviving structure in which Lincoln maintained working law offices.  
Guided Tour. 9 - 4 Closed: Sun. & Mon., Sept. - April.
- **Lincoln Depot** (30 min.)  
Lincoln's Farewell Address was delivered at this site, as he departed his beloved Springfield.  
Visit includes a/v program.  
Guided tour. 10 - 4 Closed: Sept. - May.
- **Illinois State Capitol** (30 min.)\*  
Watch House and Senate proceedings when Legislature is in session. Guided tour.  
Mon.-Fri. 8 - 4, Sat. - Sun. 9 - 3
- **Illinois State Capitol Complex Visitors Center** (30 Min.) Provides information and exhibits about the Capitol Complex and Illinois. Exhibits, a/v program. Vehicle/bus parking. Picnic areas - covered shelters, restrooms, vending machines. (No change available on site.) Mon.-Fri. 9 - 4
- **Illinois State Museum** (approx. 1 hr.)  
Permanent and changing exhibits tell the story of Illinois land, life, people and art. Exciting new, and interactive natural history exhibits. Changes: Dynamic Illinois Environments, and exciting new interactive natural history exhibit, explores 500 million years of Illinois environments. Self-guided tour.

### North Side of Springfield

- ◆ **Lincoln Tomb State Historic Site** (30 min.)  
Dedicated in 1874, Lincoln Tomb is the final resting place of Abraham Lincoln, his wife Mary, and three of their four sons, Edward, William, and Thomas.  
Guided tour. 9 - 5 Closed: Sun. & Mon., Sept. - April.
- **Illinois WWII, Vietnam Veterans and Korean War Veterans Memorial** (20 min.)  
The names of Illinois Vietnam War KIA, POW and MIA veterans and Korean War KIA veterans are listed on these two walls. WWII Globe symbolizing conflict of more than 200 nations. Self-guided tour. 9 - 5

### 30 Minutes Northwest of Springfield

- ◆ **Lincoln's New Salem State Historic Site** (2 hrs.)  
(If you select this site, state a.m. or p.m. preference.) Reconstructed log cabin village. Lincoln lived here as a young man. Visitors Center - exhibits, a/v program, restrooms. Self-guided tour. 9 - 5 Closed: Mon. & Tues., Sept. - April.
